The Senate, the House of Representatives, and the King of Antigua and Barbuda make up the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda. The Senate is Antigua and Barbuda's upper chamber of Parliament. The Governor General appoints its seventeen members.

What is the highest law in Antigua and Barbuda?

Officers of each house (President, Vice President; Speaker, Deputy Speaker) are all elected by members of those houses. The Cabinet is appointed by the Prime Minister, and members of the Cabinet must be either a member of the Senate or the House of Representatives.
