

Is Xsabo Power a solar power plant?

The Kabulasoke solar power plant is the first to be developed by the company, thus the name "Pilot Solar Power Park Kabulasoke" as stated in its license. In September 2015, Xsabo Power received a provisional generation licence, which was modified in February 2016.

What does Xsabo Lira stand for?

The Xsabo Lira Power Station (Xsabo Lira Solarline) is a US\$45 million 50 MW/AC solar power plant in Uganda that will be implemented as a "Public-Private-Partnership (PPP)" with Lira District Local Government. The corresponding Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has been approved by the Attorney General of the Republic of Uganda.
