

Does Azerbaijan have a strategic energy cooperation with the EU?

Commissioner for Energy, Kadri Simson, said: "The EU and Azerbaijan's strategic energy cooperation has shown all its flexibility and dynamism. In 2019, there was only gas on the horizon. Not today. The Southern Gas Corridor has evolved to become a forum for cooperation also on renewables and electrification.

Why did Azerbaijan sign a new energy agreement?

The document was signed by Azerbaijan's President Ilham Aliyev and European Commission President Ursula von der Leyen as part of the latter's visit to Baku. While addressing a joint press briefing, President Aliyev explained the newly signed document came as a result of the 15-year-long active energy cooperation between the sides.

Will Azerbaijan double the flow of gas to Europe in 5 years?

European Commission President Ursula von der Leyen and Azerbaijani President Ilham Aliyev close the deal on July 18. (president.az) The European Union is hailing a new energy agreement with Azerbaijan that could see the gas-rich Caspian nation double the flow of gas to Europe in five years, part of Brussels' effort to reduce reliance on Russia.

How much gas will Azerbaijan deliver to the EU this year?

EU Commissioner for Energy Kadri Simson confirmed that under the memorandum Azerbaijan is "expected" to deliver an extra 4 billion cubic meters (bcm) of gas to the EU this year (bringing the total to 12 bcm) and to increase transfers to "at least" 20 bcm by 2027.

How will Azerbaijan contribute to the repowerEU plan?

This will contribute to the diversification objectives in the REPowerEU Plan and help Europe to end its dependency on Russian gas. Based on the strengthened energy cooperation, Azerbaijan is already now increasing deliveries of natural gas to the EU, from 8.1 billion cubic metres in 2021 to an expected 12 bcm in 2022.
