

# Barbados solar power requirements for a house

What is the installed solar PV capacity in Barbados?

The total installed solar PV capacity in Barbados is about 22MW(12MW RER +10MW utility).

Does Barbados use solar panels?

Solar panels are seen more and more frequently across Barbados. Similar to the ubiquitous solar water heater on Barbadian rooftops, the Government of Barbados is fully committed to the idea of renewable energy and solar PV, thereby preparing the country for even more substantial growth in this sector.

Are Barbadians aware of solar energy usage & benefits?

Barbadians are aware of solar energy usage and benefits. Over the past few years, solar electricity systems have decreased dramatically in cost and more systems have been installed. As a result, the awareness level of Barbadians regarding solar energy has increased. In 2001, the installed capacity of solar PV in Barbados was 37 kW. Below is a list of the largest of these systems at that time:

6 ???&#0183; The house is powered by five (5) sets of four (4) photovoltaic (PV) panel arrays leading to 2 kilowatts (KW). These are used to maintain the charge in 12 deep cycle batteries which will actually power the house.

From this calculation, you can estimate that a house with these power requirements would need about 25 panels that produce 320 W. Take the amount of sun your home receives into consideration.

For a solar PV system, that means using electricity in your house during the day when the sun is shining and your solar PV system is generating the electricity.
