

What is the battery breakthrough initiative?

Announced in the 2024-25 Federal Budget in May, the Battery Breakthrough Initiative aims to fund projects that enhance the development of Australia's battery manufacturing capability to improve supply chain resilience and provide opportunities for Australia's economy and workforce in the renewable energy transition.

Why is Australia investing \$500 million in the battery breakthrough initiative?

Investing more than \$500 million to establish the Battery Breakthrough Initiative to grow Australia's battery manufacturing capabilities. This investment will see Australian industry secure more value from our natural resources, diversify global battery supply chains and support the global transition to net zero.
