Battery storage deployment has not been as fast in France, or indeed much of mainland Europe, as it has been in markets like the US, UK and latterly Australia. RTE is conducting a pilot project, called Project RINGO, which will see just under 100MWh of battery storage deployed across three French sites that act as virtual transmission assets.

What makes a site suitable for battery storage? Sites can be quite small, usually starting at around 1 acre, and can reach up to 5 acres or more. The best sites are relatively flat, at least 100m away from the nearest homes and are well screened - although landscape planting can be added as part of the project.

Battery energy storage system generally uses electro-chemical ways to store energy. It can also store energy through renewable sources of energy such as wind and solar. Energy storage through renewable and natural sources helps to save the costs required for production of energy. Power storage is an added benefit as it helps

This total includes biomass, hydropower, battery storage and solar photovoltaic (PV) projects. In October last year, the French firm and its partner Banque des Territoires, part of France's Groupe Caisse des Depots brought online a 2.6 MW/2.9 MWh battery at their 3.8-MW Savane des Peres solar park in French Guiana.
