The battery is situated within Voltalia''s Toco energy storage complex, touted as one of the largest ones of its kind in France with a capacity of 19 MW/27 MWh. At present, Voltalia operates 48 MW of solar, hydropower, biomass and energy storage assets in French Guiana. The firm started building Parc Sable Blanc in November 2011.

A second installation phase has been completed at TotalEnergies" battery energy storage facility in Dunkirk, northern France, bringing its output and capacity to 61MW / 61MWh. The battery energy storage system (BESS) was already France"s biggest system of its type -- at 25MW / 25MWh -- when it was inaugurated in January 2021.
