

Could Sardinia occupy a unique position in the Mediterranean?

Does Sardinia have an electrification plan?

We believe that it is "yes", says Starace. In specific terms, the electrification plan for Sardinia is based on the island's natural resources, specifically sun, wind and water, all of which are in abundance.

What is Enel's plan for Sardinia?

This will connect Sardinia to Italy's national grid. The deadline for closing down coal-fired power plants is 2025. In some cases, gas is seen as a temporary alternative but, as Starace points out, there is no gas in Sardinia and therefore this phase can be "skipped" altogether.

In other words, Sardinia is perfect for sustainable tourism. The reason for this optimism is well founded.

Will decarbonisation skip the gas stage in Sardinia?

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The project is expected to supply enough clean energy to power 650,000 households. The project cost is expected to be around \$1,705m. The turbines will be mounted on floating type foundations and will be interconnected by 66kV inter-array cable.
