Who are the British Virgin Islanders?

British Virgin Islanders are British Overseas Territories citizens and since 2002, are also British citizens. The islands were named 'Santa y las Once Mil Virgenes' by Christopher Columbus in 1493 after the legend of Saint Ursula and the 11,000 virgins. The name was later shortened to 'the Virgin Islands'.

Are British Virgin Islanders British citizens?

British Virgin Islanders are classed as British Overseas Territories citizens and since 2002 have had full British citizenship. The Virgin Islands were first settled by the Arawak from South America around 100 BC (though there is some evidence of Amerindian presence on the islands as far back as 1500 BC).

What type of government does the BVI have?

The BVI is a British Overseas Territory. The government is a parliamentary democracy elected and regulated by the Constitution of the British Virgin Islands. The BVI islanders, as they are called, are predominantly of African descent and stem from the plantation history of slavery in the BVI. To date, the demographic mix is about 75 percent black.
