Can you put cabinets under a kitchen sink?

Here are our guidelines for using the cabinets under your kitchen sink effectively and safely. Don't store anything paper under the sink. An obvious one: Steer clear of putting anything made of paper, like paper towels or paper bags, under the sink, as these things could become damaged or unusable in the unlikely event that your pipes leak.

Can you store items under a kitchen sink?

'As long as the items you're storing under the kitchen sink are not hazardous or flammable, or won't spoil, it should be okay to store them there. To keep your belongings safe, we're sharing common items you should never store under the sink.
