What are the dimensions of a wardrobe?

Here are the key dimensions and tips that will help you create the perfect wardrobe for your needs. Hinged wardrobes have front doors fixed with simple hinges and are one of the most traditional wardrobe designs. Depth: The standard depth of a hinged wardrobe is 24 inches.

Do wardrobes have doors?

Yes, wardrobes typically have doors that enclose the storage space. The doors can be hinged or sliding, allowing easy access to the contents within. The doors help keep the clothing protected, organised, and free from dust or damage.

How wide should a wardrobe door be?

This is especially important for children's or spare bedrooms that may be on the smaller side. Keep the maximum width of a single hinged door on a built in wardrobe in a bedroom to around 600-650mm (24 inches). This will allow for flexibility of furniture placement in the room and also avoid any warping on larger doors.

Can a freestanding wardrobe be used as a bedroom storage solution?

Yes,a freestanding wardrobe can be used as a standalone bedroom storage solution. If there is enough room, they can also be combined with another freestanding wardrobe to create a larger storage solution. Open Wardrobes: Open wardrobes are becoming more popular, so if you like the minimalist approach, an open clothes rail could be just right for you. Designs often feature a combination of hanging rails and shelving.

How much clearance should a wardrobe have?

When installing a wardrobe, allow for 1cm width clearance and 4cm height clearance. This ensures that the doors can fully open and there is a little space between the top of the wardrobe and the ceiling.
