



# Cocos Keeling Islands solar island system

What are the Cocos (Keeling) Islands?

The Cocos (Keeling) Islands consist of the main atoll of Cocos, and the isolated North Keeling (Pulu Keeling) which is Australia's smallest Commonwealth National Park.

Where are the Cocos Islands?

The Cocos (Keeling) Islands are an Australian Territory in the eastern Indian Ocean, and comprise an atoll that has had a particularly significant place in the development of coral reef studies.

How do the Cocos (Keeling) Islands communicate?

The Cocos (Keeling) Islands have access to a range of modern communication services. Digital television stations are broadcast from Western Australia via satellite. A local radio station, 6CKI - Voice of the Cocos (Keeling) Islands, is staffed by community volunteers and provides some local content.

How do you get to the Cocos (Keeling) Islands?

Just don't do both." Unless you have a yacht and a lot of time, or your own plane, the only way to the Cocos (Keeling) Islands is a twice-weekly Virgin flight out of Perth in Western Australia. Only about 4,000 tourists made it here in all of last year.

How many islands are in the Cocos Islands?

The Cocos (Keeling) Islands comprise a southern horseshoe-shaped atoll (South Keeling Islands, hereafter referred to as Cocos) with more than 20 sandy reef islands around a shallow lagoon (Figure 1), and a northern reef island with a small remnant lagoonlet, North Keeling.
