

What is the largest solar power plant in Portugal?

On 9 October 2021, the largest solar power plant in Portugal was inaugurated in Alcútem. With an installed capacity of 219 MW, the power plant has 661,500 solar panels and can power the needs of 200,000 homes. It occupies an area of 320 hectares and will prevent the emission of 326,000 tons of carbon dioxide every year.

Is solar power a growing source of energy in Portugal?

Solar power is a growing source in the Portuguese energy mix. At the end of 2020, solar power installed capacity totalled 1.03 GW and represented 3.6% of total power generation in 2020. Portugal has set a goal of between 8.1 GW and 9.9 GW in installed capacity by 2030.

How much solar power will Portugal produce in 2023?

Solar installed capacity reached 1.03 GW by the end of 2020, accounting for 3.6 percent of the total production of power. Portugal established a target of 6.4 gigawatts of installed capacity by 2023, with a goal of 9 gigawatts by 2030. A plant in Coruche will generate seventy megawatt-hours each year.

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A new solar power plant, described as the largest in Portugal and one of the largest unsubsidised solar power plants in Europe, was inaugurated in the Eastern Algarve borough of Alcoutim on Saturday morning (October 9). Spanning the parishes of Vaqueiros and Martim Longo, the plant is able to produce 219 megawatts (MW) of solar power.

At the end of June, Portugal had 2,980 megawatts (MW) of photovoltaic capacity in operation, 419 MW more than the existing solar power at the end of 2022.
