

Falkland Islands sand battery

The Falkland Islands must surely be considered amongst the best places in the world in which to walk. With such a sparse human population it is rare to meet anyone else outside Stanley. The name "Falkland Islands" comes from Falkland Sound, the strait that separates the two main islands.
