The National Sustainable Energy Strategy 2012-2033 set the 2033 goals of becoming a net electricity and biofuels exporter, increasing GDP energy intensity by 30%, tripling energy recovery from waste streams, and reducing fossil fuel imports by 50%. In addition, it restates Belize's goal of generating over 50% of electricity from renewable energy.

Solar energy in Belize is currently limited to off-grid use. In Belize, off-grid solar systems are particularly relevant for tourist destinations, such as the cayes and eco-tourism lodges in the rainforest, which are not connected to the national grid. Voltage and wattage in Belize. Belize uses 110 volts, 60 cycle electricity, the same as the US. The standard voltage is 110 / 220 V at a frequency of 60 Hz. If you are from the US, you will not typically need a converter or adapter as the voltage in Belize is in the same 100-120 volt range as the US.
