How to replace alternator belt?

Slide the old belt off the alternator pulley and other accessory pulleys, then route the new belt according to the diagram provided by the manufacturer. Finally, use the tensioner pulley to apply the appropriate tension to the belt and secure it in place.

To remove the main serpentine belt connected to your alternator, use your breaker bar and a 13mm socket on the tensioner pulley bolt and rotate counterclockwise to relieve tension on the ...
