

Why do Finns need emergency supplies?

Individual emergency planning and action affect individuals' and communities' ability to cope. According to a population survey conducted by the Ministry of the Interior in September, 58 per cent of Finns have acquired home emergency supplies for crisis situations, i.e. food, money and supplies.

Overview. In Finland, Rescue Services operate under the Rescue Act (379/2011) and other similar acts. The Department for Rescue Services at the Ministry of the Interior is in charge of the organisation of rescue services at national level, guides and directs rescue services, and coordinates the activities of various ministries and sectors in the field of rescue services ...

Emergency Medical Treatment. In Finland, emergency medical treatment can be obtained at any hospital emergency room or health center. The emergency rooms are open 24 hours a day and can provide immediate medical attention for serious illnesses or injuries. In addition, there are specialized emergency care units for certain types of medical ...

The Government, in cooperation with the President of the Republic, has declared a state of emergency in Finland due to COVID-19. In its plenary session on Monday 1 March, the Government declared that the country is in a state of emergency as referred to in section 3, paragraph 5 of the Emergency Powers Act.

Only call the emergency number 112 in real emergencies when you need urgent assistance from the authorities (police, paramedics, firefighters, social services). Calling the emergency number is free of charge. You can call the emergency number from any mobile phone or landline without an area code.

The Emergency Response Centre Agency operates a nationwide network of ERCs under the Ministry of the Interior. The Emergency Response Centre Agency has a statutory mandate to answer emergency calls, evaluate their urgency and forward any calls that require immediate action to rescue services, the police, social services or health authorities.
