

What is the French Southern Territories?

The territory is sometimes referred to as the French Southern Lands (French: Terres australes fran&#231;aises) or the French Southern Territories, usually to emphasize non-recognition of French sovereignty over Ad&#233;lie Land as part of the Antarctic Treaty System. The entire territory has no known permanently settled inhabitants.

Is France a sovereign country?

France is a sovereign nation of the Indo-Pacific. French overseas territories include seven Regions, Departments and Communities (thereafter: overseas territories) which are home to 1.6 million French citizens: Mayotte, La Reunion, the French Southern and Antarctic territories, New Caledonia, Wallis & Futuna, and French Polynesia.

Why are French overseas territories important?

The French overseas territories host military bases and capabilities which allow for the securing of our sovereign territories as well as the commons around them. They also facilitate military cooperation, crisis anticipation and regional integration. They are essential to France's security activities in the Indo-Pacific.

Who is responsible for TAAF in France?

The TAAF are under the authority of a prefect who is at the same time the representative of the French State and the person responsible for the territory. Since 2000, the head office is located in Reunion island, where it employs nearly 65 people. It houses the Prefect's office and cabinet, the general secretariat and the various departments.
