Will Ivory Coast achieve universal energy access by 2025?

With the 2030 Energy Plan identifying 66 projects that will require private investment, the door is open for new private partners to stake their claim. Ivory Coast aims to achieve universal energy access by 2025 and triple its generation capacity by 2030.

What is EDF doing to support Ivory Coast's energy transition?

Renewable energy and... As part of its active involvement in supporting Ivory Coast's commitment to the energy transition, EDF is developing an innovative biomass power plant project in partnership with local energy players. Ivory Coast is aiming for an energy mix in which 42% will come from renewable energy by 2030.

Does Ivory Coast engage with private energy companies?

Ivory Coast's engagement with private energy companies is not unique to the region. In fact, public-private partnerships are common across West Africa as they are equally popular with governments and private companies.

How much will Ivory Coast Invest in oil?

Last June, Ivory Coast's President Alassane Ouattara revealed plans for more than \$15 billion in investment in the country's oil sector. The President further projected an increase in oil output from 60,000 bpd - come the startup of Baleine's Phase 2 - to 200,000 bpd within the next five years.

Is Ivory Coast a good place to live?

Ivory Coast is on an economic roll: since 2011, GDP growth has averaged 8% per year making it not just one of the most dynamic countries in sub-Saharan Africa, but the world. With the economy and energy demand booming, the Ivorian government has put the energy sector at the top of its agenda.

What is the largest oil discovery in Ivory Coast?

Estimated to contain up to 2.5 billion barrels of oil and 3.3 trillion cubic feet of natural gas, the Baleine field is the largest oil discovery in Ivory Coast. The project is also expected to become the first emissions-free upstream development project in Africa under Scope 1 and 2 of the global standard Greenhouse Gas Protocol.
