



# Home assistant storage Cabo Verde

How do I backup my Home Assistant data?

When you are ready with the backups, boot your Home Assistant OS from the SD card as usual and connect the SSD drive to any of the blue USB ports (USB 3.0) on your device, as they are faster. Open your Home Assistant web interface and go to: Settings > System > Storage > Three Dots Menu (upper right corner) > then select Move datadisk.

How do I store backups outside of home assistant?

Storing backups outside of Home Assistant makes sure they don't use space on Home Assistant to begin with. It also makes sure you can restore Home Assistant from backup in case you have an issue with your current installation. Go to Settings > System > Backups, and from the list of backups, select the backup you want to keep.

How do I expand my home assistant storage?

When you are running Home Assistant Operating System, you can use the following options to expand your storage: Replace your current storage medium, for example, the SD card, with a bigger one. Use a backup to restore Home Assistant from backup on the new SD card.

How do I restore home assistant to a new SD card?

Use a backup to restore Home Assistant from backup on the new SD card. If you are running Home Assistant as a VM, look at the documentation for your hypervisor on how to expand disks for virtual machines. Home Assistant will auto-expand to use the newly added space.

Hi, not a bloody noob on Linux here. So I did a little research also here on the forum regarding my issue but couldn't find any answers. So let's start: Setting Running HassOS on a Synology Disk Station with the build in Hypervisor (Virtual Machine Manager). I installed the HassOS by downloading the prepared OVA image/disk. Since I didn't change anything I left ...

Most HA implementations run on Raspberry Pi's with either SD card or SSD as storage. This is significant because disk space may be limited, the life expectancy of these devices is compromised by the number of write cycles, and large log files and databases slow down performance because system resources is not unlimited. One would therefore expect ...

Not running Proxmox myself, but my installation is running on ESXi. I expanded my storage simply by shutting down the virtual machine, increased the size of the virtual disk and then started it back up, Home Assistant automatically claimed the extra space I had given it. 4GB RAM should be more than enough to run this, unless you use a a large amount of add-ons. ...

16 gigs of storage space is more than enough. I'm using a 32 gig card myself but never get below 92% of storage space left. I would not recommend a too old sd card though. A fast sd card really helps to run ...
