How much does it cost to install solar panels?

According to our solar experts, solar panels cost about \$19,000to install in the United States, on average. While the price tag seems steep, incentives and payment options help make the cost of going solar easier to manage. The total cost of a solar installation depends on your location, energy usage, and even the type of equipment you use!

How much does a solar system cost?

Solar panel costs are calculated by the price per watt. The average price per watt in the U.S. is \$3.67for an 8.6 kW system (rounded up). Compare the average cost of solar in the U.S. based on system size before applying incentives. To estimate how much a system will cost, multiply the price per watt by the system size.

Are solar panels worth it?

Solar panels can generate major savingsif you're trying to reduce your electricity costs, carbon emissions or both. The primary factor in determining whether or not solar panels are worthwhile for you is the cost you're currently paying for electricity. The higher your electricity costs, the more a solar panel system will save you in the long run.

How much does solar energy cost per watt?

The cost per watt is what you pay for each unit of power of your solar energy system. Think of it a little like "price per square foot" when you buy a house. It helps compare the value of solar energy systems in different sizes. As of publishing, the average cost per watt is \$2.84.

How much does a 5 kilowatt solar system cost?

The average 5-kilowatt (kW) solar panel system is \$14,210before considering any financial incentives. However, a typical American household needs a system closer to 10 kW to adequately power their home, which costs \$28,241 in 2024. That price effectively drops to \$19,873 after considering the full federal solar tax credit.

Where does solar cost the most?

We generally see this trend on EnergySage (though there are some outliers),with lower \$/W pricing in warmer states and higher \$/W pricing in colder states. Arizona has the lowest average cost of solar,while Maine and New Hampshirehave some of the highest prices.
