Do HOAs allow solar panels?

When you install solar, your HOA has the right to make sure you or your installer have all the necessary permits to operate, your panels meet certain design requirements, or dictate the placement of your solar panels. Some HOAs allow solar panels but only if they're placed on the back of the home's roof so it's not visible from the street.

Can a HOA deny a solar installation in Indiana?

The House Enrolled Act 1196 fortified solar access laws in Indiana, allowing residents to petition HOAs attempting to deny installations.

Can a restrictive covenant protect a solar energy collector?

Can a neighbor cut down a tree that blocks solar panels?

For example, let's say you install solar panels but your neighbor has trees that grow too close to your roof and block the sun from hitting your panels. In this case, you may obtain a solar easement that instructs your neighbors to trim or cut down the tree that blocks your access to the sun.
