How to install solar panels for free in India?

There is no government scheme for installing solar panels for free in India. However, the government announced the Rooftop Solar Scheme or the PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana, which aims to install solar panels in houses and achieve solar energy generation and usage in households.

What is solar subsidy scheme in India?

Under the scheme, households will be provided with a subsidy to install solar panels on their roofs. The subsidy will cover up to 40% of the cost of the solar panels. The scheme is expected to benefit 1 crore households across India. It is estimated that the scheme will save the government Rs. 75,000 crore per year in electricity costs.

How to apply for rooftop solar scheme?

Applicants should have their own residence with a roof suitable for installing solar panels. Applicants must have a valid electricity connection. Applicants should not have availed of any other subsidy for solar panels. Under the Rooftop Solar Scheme, the government will provide the below subsidies for installing solar panels:
