Infinity Power is a joint venture between Egyptian developer Infinity and UAE-based investment firm Masdar. Masdar also owns UK developer Masdar Arlington Energy. Construction on the BESS will start in early 2024 and is expected to be completed and operational in 2025, and will be among the largest such projects in West Africa.

Infinity Power's existing operational portfolio across Egypt (where it operates the 252MW West Bakr wind farm), South Africa and Senegal comprises 1.3 gigawatts (GW) of solar power and onshore wind farms. The company is targeting 10GW of operational renewable energy in Africa by 2030 at an estimated investment of \$5 billion.
