How much solar power does Ireland have in 2024?

Discover the latest findings from the Irish Solar Energy Association (ISEA) in our 2024 Scale of Solar report. Ireland has experienced a remarkable 42.6% increase in solar capacity, now reaching 1,185MW. This surge is equivalent to powering 280,000 homes annually, reduce carbon emissions by 270,000 tonnes, and includes 373MW from domestic rooftops.

What does the 'scale of solar' report mean for Ireland?

The Irish Solar Energy Association's 'Scale of Solar' report highlights the remarkable growth of solar energy in Ireland and its significant impact on redefining our dependency on fossil fuels.

Why is Ireland launching a solar energy project?

Conall Bolger, CEO of the Irish Solar Energy Association (ISEA), agreed with Mansoldo and Tarrant that the milestone reflects a growing excitement within the Irish population for solar technology. "It is driven by its environmental benefits and potential cost savings," he told pv magazine.

Is solar the fastest growing renewable power source in Ireland?

ESB Networks recently stated that solar is "the fastest growing renewable power source in Ireland." This exciting progress was unlocked by two changes: removal of barriers to rooftop solar; and a route to market emerging for utility scale ground mount solar. Consumers are placing solar on their homes and businesses at an unprecedented rate.

Will increasing solar capacity increase electricity generation in Ireland?

Our RESS-3 report, produced by AFRY, found that increasing solar capacity will result in a more balanced energy mix and, since RESS-3 solar is curtailed less than RESS-3 onshore wind, this allows for increased electricity generation from renewables in Ireland.

Is Ireland a good place to invest in solar energy?

Ireland has among the highest cost renewables in the world. We would welcome a review of the policy and state factors influencing those costs. We incur a higher price than needed for our energy transition. The future is bright for solar in Ireland if we grasp the opportunity.
