Last June, Ivory Coast's President Alassane Ouattara revealed plans for more than \$15 billionin investment in the country's oil sector. The President further projected an increase in oil output from 60,000 bpd - come the startup of Baleine's Phase 2 - to 200,000 bpd within the next five years.
