

Abidjan, Cote d'Ivoire - 27 May 2024 - The Global Green Growth Institute (GGGI) and the Korea International Cooperation Agency (KOICA) have signed a Grant Funding Agreement of 8,250,000USD to implement a groundbreaking initiative aimed at strengthening the digital landscape of Ivory Coast, fostering green entrepreneurship among the youth ...

The financing of ZECI's (Zola EDF Cote d'Ivoire) "Solar Home Systems" business aims to address this issue by providing solar home systems to off-grid populations in Ivory Coast. ZECI is a company co-founded by EDF and Zola Electric that sells on credit and ensures the maintenance of solar kits to meet the needs of rural off-grid populations.

According to the code of nationality in Ivory Coast "Any individual born in Ivory Coast is an Ivorian citizen unless both parents are foreigners; Any individual born out of Ivory Coast from an Ivorian parent is an Ivorian citizen". The nationality is therefore acquired primarily by the blood and not by the right of the soil.

Ivory Coast - The Education System The education system. The education system comprised three stages: primary school lasted six years, leading to a certificate of primary studies; secondary school lasted seven years, leading to a certificate or baccalauréat. University education, available only in Abidjan, culminated in a university degree.
