

Where are the Cocos Keeling Islands?

Flip open a map of Australia, wave a magnifying glass some 2700 kilometres north-west of Perth and you'll find Cocos Keeling Islands glistening in the Indian Ocean. Look closer: 27 sand-smudged islands don't so much leap from the ocean, as lay luxuriating in blissful blue-gem waters.

Are homestays available on Cocos (Keeling) Islands?

Homestays are available on Home Island, and can be arranged through Zulaika at the Island Brunch Cafe. The Cocos (Keeling) Islands 'Weekly Dining Guide' is an indispensable restaurant guide for visitors. The restaurants and cafes on Cocos (Keeling) Islands keep sporadic opening hours.

How do I get to Cocos Keeling Island?

To get to Cocos Keeling Island, hop on a flight from Singapore to Perth. From there, the islands are accessible via Virgin Australia flights from Perth, which operate twice weekly. The flight from Perth to Cocos Keeling Islands takes slightly less than 6 hours. The airport is located on West Island.

Why are the Cocos Islands called the Keeling Islands?

The territory's dual name (official since the islands' incorporation into Australia in 1955) reflects that the islands have historically been known as either the Cocos Islands or the Keeling Islands. The territory consists of two atolls made up of 27 coral islands, of which only two - West Island and Home Island - are inhabited.

Like mainland Australia, most transactions on Cocos (Keeling) Islands are cashless with credit cards being widely accepted. There are no banks on Cocos (Keeling) Islands but cards can be used at the post office to withdraw cash from Australian banks.
