



# New solar power projects in China

How many solar and wind power projects are being built in China?

In July, China hit its target of having 1,200 gigawatts of installed solar and wind capacity, enough to power hundreds of millions of homes each year, six years early. There is more to come: around two-thirds of all new solar and wind power projects under construction are happening in China.

What is China's largest solar plant?

China continues its relentless expansion of solar power capacity, now home to the world's largest solar plant. The 2.2 gigawatt facility spans an area of over 25 square kilometers in the Gobi desert. This \$3 billion flagship project demonstrates the epic scale of renewable infrastructure developing worldwide.

Does China have a commitment to building renewables projects?

The stark contrast in construction rates illustrates the active nature of China's commitment to building renewables projects. How much solar power does China have in 2023?

China added almost twice as much utility-scale solar and wind power capacity in 2023 than in any other year. By the first quarter of 2024, China's total utility-scale solar and wind capacity reached 758 GW, though data from China Electricity Council put the total capacity, including distributed solar, at 1,120 GW.

How many concentrated solar power projects will China build by 2024?

By 2024 China is building 30 Concentrated Solar Power Projects as part of gigawatt-scale renewable energy complexes in each province, appropriately reflecting the urgency and scale needed for climate action
