Named after individual people: Captain John Heard, American sealer who sighted the island on 25 November 1853 & Captain William McDonald, who discovered the McDonald Islands close to Heard Island six weeks later, on 4 January 1854

The barren island of Heard and McDonald were once under the United Kingdom before it became a territory of Australia. The UK union jack flag is considered the only previous flag to have been used on the Heard and McDonald Islands. It was first hoisted on the island in 1910. Later on, in 1947, the island fell into Australian authority, and since ...

Big Ben has erupted several times over the past two decades. McDonald Island lies 43.5 kilometres due west of Heard Island, and is the major island in the McDonald Islands group. It is a mere 186 metres high and it too has an active volcano. The McDonald Islands are so volcanically active they have doubled in area since 1980.
