



# Photovoltaic panel agency contract

Can a provider sell a photovoltaic system to a customer?

WHEREAS, Provider has offered, at his sole cost and expense, to install, maintain, own, replace, repair, and operate a photovoltaic system at one or more of the Property (ies) and to sell Solar Services (as hereafter defined) produced by the solar photovoltaic system to Customer as provided in and subject to the provisions of this Agreement.

What is a solar service provider (SPPA)?

With this business model, the host customer buys the services produced by the PV system rather than the PV system itself. This framework is referred to as the "solar services" model, and the developers who offer SPPAs are known as solar services providers.

Who is a PV installer?

A PV installer is defined as a person who is directly engaged with the electrical connection and wiring of a photovoltaic system project in a capacity other than as an inspector, management planner, consultant, project designer, contractor or supervisor for the photovoltaic system project

Can a contractor stop a PV system?

The Contractor may be ordered to stop work, or shut the systems down, if unsafe conditions or code violations are noted. The warranty holder or a roofing contractor certified by the roof manufacturer shall inspect the PV systems to ensure the integrity of the installation.

How does GSA work with Solar Contractors?

GSA will only work with companies that have been in business for at least two years and have a balance sheet of sales greater than \$75,000 each of the last two years. Solar contractors can also pursue federal government work through subcontracting opportunities.
