This is one of the most common ways 'fake' solar companies have targeted consumers - whereby they take a hefty deposit and then never turn up to carry out the installation. This is common solar scam.

How do I know if a solar company is a scam?

Be wary of solicitors. Always verify the identity and credentials of anyone claiming to represent a solar company. Unscrupulous solar companies may employ aggressive or dishonest sales tactics to close deals quickly, especially if the proposed solar installation isn't in your best interest.

How do I protect myself from solar scams?

Protecting yourself from solar scams means taking a proactive approach and following a few key strategies.
