How has ignite impacted Rwanda's last-mile communities?

Ignite's agents have visited various last-mile communities in Rwanda's rural districts, gathering testimonials about life before and after gaining access to power. The impact is overwhelmingly positive. Progress is significant for these communities after gaining access to power, but it is unequal across the world.

With a potential of 4.5 kWh per m² per day and approximately 5 peak sun hours, solar energy has a huge potentiality in Rwanda. Currently, Rwanda's total on-grid installed solar energy is 12.050 MW originating from 3 solar power plants namely Jali power plant generating 0.25MW, Rwamagana Gigawatt generating 8.5 MW, and the Nasho Solar plant generating 3.3 MW.

Development in Rural Area (Rwanda).
