Saint-Pierre and Miquelon's health care system is entirely public and free. In 1994, France and Canada signed an agreement allowing the residents of the archipelago to be treated in St. John's.

The islands are a well-known separate country-level entity among many radio amateurs, identifiable with ITU prefix “FP”. Those visiting, mainly from the US, activate Saint-Pierre and Miquelon every year on amateur frequencies.

Do Saint Pierre & Miquelon have a car registration plate?

In the past, Saint Pierre and Miquelon used only standard French vehicle registration plates, rather than plates in the format of six inches (150 mm) high by twelve inches (300 mm) wide used by most other jurisdictions in North America.

How did Saint-Pierre and Miquelon become a territory?

After the 1958 French constitutional referendum, the territory of Saint-Pierre and Miquelon was asked to choose one of three options: becoming fully integrated with France, becoming a self-governing state within the French Community, or preserving the status of an overseas territory; it decided to remain a territory.
