How many trees are planted in Saudi Arabia?

Since the launch of the Saudi Green Initiative, over 18 million trees have been planted, and 17 new initiatives launched across the country to restore natural greenery and protect against the impacts of climate change. Out of the total, 13 million trees planted in the Kingdom this year have been mangroves.

According to Patalong [12], Saudi Arabia has set ambitious goals for renewable energy, hoping to reach 27.3 GW by 2024 and 58.7 GW by 2030.
