However, the overwhelming number of state-owned enterprises, such as the Sierra Leone National Shipping Company, the Guma Valley Water Company, the Sierra Leone Postal Services and Sierratel, are still wholly under government control. State-established safety nets that compensate for the social risks of capitalism are negligible.

With military support from Libya, Burkina Faso, and most notably neighboring Liberia, the RUF brought large parts of eastern and southern Sierra Leone under its control. The Sierra Leonean military disagreed with the political leadership over how to tackle the crisis and replaced the civilian government in a military coup in 1992.

However, since the end of the war, Sierra Leone's administrations have shown a tendency to favor civil society actors that share their own political and economic interests over those who oppose or challenge their interests. The same is true regarding the government's relationship with the media.

It remains dependent on international partners and investors to sustain reform efforts and retain a minimal degree of stability. Past administrations were committed to presenting Sierra Leone as a credible and reliable partner in the international community.

Is corruption a major obstacle to development in Sierra Leone?
