



Solar power meter installation

What is a solar power meter?

A solar power meter is a device that measures solar power or sunlight in units of W/m^2 , either through windows to verify their efficiency or when installing solar power devices. Solar meters accumulate PV yield production and local energy consumption to monitor and analyze PV plant performance.

Twist the wires together and insert them into the terminal. Securely tighten the terminal screws. 2. Terminate the SolarEdge device as described in Installing and Connecting the Meter on page 7. The built-in RGM is pre-configured as a production meter and its settings should not be changed.
