Are capped landfills a good place to install solar power?

Capped landfills are increasingly attractive locations for new solar power installations. This is an unsurprising trend, since the number of active landfills is decreasing, leaving state and local governments with significant unusable parcels of land. The EPA estimates there are as many as 7,400 closed landfills in the country.

Will solar development damage the landfill cap?

One concern often voiced is related to the possibility that the solar development may cause damage to the landfill cap by causing hazardous materials to leach out of the landfill and into the groundwater.

Can solar panels go on top of a landfill?

In addition, landfill closure permits for landfills need to be re-written in order to allow solar panels to go on top, which adds time and cost to the project.

Are solar farms a viable alternative to capped landfills?

While it's not unheard of for capped landfills to become parks or golf courses, solar farms can be a more feasible alternative, as there's no need to prepare or maintain the site to accommodate the public.
