

Solar tÃ©rmica Wallis and Futuna

In 1991, BNP Nouvelle-Calédonie, a subsidiary of BNP Paribas, established a subsidiary, Banque de Wallis-et-Futuna, in the territory. Two years earlier Banque Indosuez had closed its branch at Mata-Utu, leaving the territory without any bank. Following this, the Bank of Wallis-and-Futuna (BWF) with its head office in Wallis was created in 1991.

Wallis is a volcanic island with cones and crater lakes to explore, and Futuna and Alofi lure the occasional traveller with mountainous landscapes covered in tropical forests and untouched coastline. Citizens of most countries can travel to Wallis and Futuna visa-free " some for unlimited time and some for a period of up to 90 days.
