How much power does South Sudan need?

South Sudan's installed power capacity is about 130 megawatts, a large chunk of which is used to supply electricity to the country's abundant oil fields. However, the country's power demand is about 300 megawatts, an amount that's likely to grow during peacetime, Deng said. "We are actually thirsty [for generation]," he said.

Can South Sudan generate electricity from hydropower?

South Sudan holds the potential to generate over 2,500 MW of electricity from hydropower, mostly in its equatorial region. Fula, Shukoli, Lakki, and Bedden are among the largest project sites that have been identified on the Nile River with the potential to be developed and are estimated to generate 2,927 MW of power.

How can South Sudan increase electricity access?

In a bid to increase electricity access in South Sudan, State company South Sudan Electricity Corporation plans to develop a 120 MW hydropower plant and to roll out planned regional interconnection transmission line projects.

Are South Sudan & Ethiopia collaborating on regional energy cooperation?

Following a meeting between a delegation from South Sudan's Ministry of Energy and Dams, led by H.E. Minister Peter Marcello and state-owned electric producer, Ethiopian Electric Power, the two countries formally targeted regional energy cooperation, with specifics outlined in a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).

Why is South Sudan so rich in hydro?

"South Sudan is very rich in terms of hydro because we have the potential; this is where we are going to increase access to 50%," he said. The existing 296km, 230kV Ethiopia-Sudan interconnection transmission line also faces plans for expansion, although materialization of the project remains dependent on investment.
