Why did a tanker carry Iranian oil to Syria?

LONDON, Dec 9 (Reuters) - A tanker carrying Iranian oil to Syria turned round in the Red Sea to head away from its original destination after the fall of Syrian President Bashar al-Assad. How has Syria's Civil War impacted the oil industry?

A more than decade-long ravaging civil war has been detrimental to Syria's oil sector since its breakout in 2011, crashing crude output to only 10,000 b/d in 2016 before it started to recover in 2018.

How much oil does Syria produce a day?

\*\*Prior to sanctions, Syria produced some 383,000 barrels per day (bpd) of oil and liquids, according to previous analysis by the U.S. Energy Information Administration (EIA). \*\*Oil and liquid production fell to 40,000 bpd in 2023, according to separate estimates from the Energy Institute.

What happened to Suncor Energy in Syria?

\*\*Canada's Suncor Energy Inc suspended its Syria operations in 2011. Its primary asset is the Ebla development located in the Central Syrian Gas Basin covering more than 300,000 acres (approximately 1,251 square kilometres). The gas field was producing 80 million cubic feet of natural gas per day.

Is Syria a narco-state?

Under heavy US sanctions, Syria turned into what some experts have called a "narco-state," fueling a drug crisis in neighboring countries.
