

Is wind power economic in West Timor-Leste?

A USAID-funded wind project has been on going in the "NTT Province" of Indonesia that also includes West Timor. Based on West Timor data, this study concludes that wind power is probably not economic in coastal areas, but it may prove to be economic in the uplands and mountains of Timor-Leste both for grid connected and off-grid applications.

How much does electricity cost in Timor-Leste?

The flat rates vary from \$3 per month for low-income consumers with a two-amp connection and 6-hour daily provision of power, to \$25 per month for connection above four amps and 24-hour access to power. Is biomass a source of electricity in East Timor?

Traditional biomass - the burning of charcoal, crop waste, and other organic matter - is not included. This can be an important source in lower-income settings. East Timor: How much of the country's electricity comes from nuclear power? Nuclear power - alongside renewables - is a low-carbon source of electricity.

How many households in Timor-Leste have access to electricity?

As noted earlier, only 20% of households in Timor-Leste have access to electricity. The Government intends to address this situation in the decade ahead with a sustained program of rural electrification.
