What is energy in Angola?

Energy in Angola describes energy and electricity production, consumption and export from Angola. The energy policy of Angola reflects energy policy and the politics of Angola. Biomass accounts for 58% of the country's energy consumption; oil accounts for 35%, gas 4% and hydroelectric power 3%.

Primary energy use in 2009 in Angola was 138 TWh and 7 TWh per million persons. Angolans used to suffer frequent daily blackouts.

What is Angola's energy mix?

Angola's current installed capacity is estimated at 5.7 GW but only 70 percent is in use. The country's current energy mix consists of 61.8 percent hydropower, 37.6 percent other fossil fuels and 0.6 percent hybrid (solar/fossil fuel).

Who produces electricity in Angola?

Electricity is produced by Empresa Nacional de Electricidade de Angola. Angola ranks second in crude oil production in sub-Saharan Africa, after Nigeria. In 2022, the country produced an average of 1.165 million barrels of oil per day, according to its National Oil, Gas and Biofuel's Agency (ANPG).

How is natural gas produced in Angola?

Refineries in Angola produce small quantities of marketed natural gas, but most of its production is flared as a by-product of oil operations or is reinjected into oil fields to increase oil recovery.

How much does Angola spend on electricity?

The portion of the Angolan government budget dedicated to the electricity production, transmission and distribution sectors increased to US\$817.2 million in 2023 from US\$490 million in 2022. Angola's national budget for electricity assessment allocated is around US\$249.4 million.
