Recently Timor Port, a subsidiary of Bolloré Ports, has received new handling equipment to boost its container terminal capacity. The order included two tugs, two Ship-to-shore (STS) gantries, and four rubber-tired gantry (RTG) cranes as part of the Tibar Bay deep seaport concession.

Who will build the port of Dili in East Timor?

The Bolloré Group won the 30-year concession to build and operate the future deep-sea port of Dili, as a public-private partnership, the first in East Timor. It selected China Harbor Engineering Company (CHEC) for the construction of the port of Tibar west of Dili, capital of East Timor.

Is Timor port a regional hub?

Timor Port is investing in new infrastructure and has regional hub ambitions as Timor Leste applies for Asean membership.

Is biomass a source of electricity in East Timor?

The government does not have policies or regulatory incentives to promote renewable energy. Timor-Leste has enacted several laws addressing environmental policies, including the Environmental Basic Law (which includes climate change adaptation and mitigation issues), the Environmental License Decree Law, the Operational Law of Clean Development ...

Timor-Leste is an island with a coastline of 760 km, territorial waters of approximately approximately 9120 km², and an Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) of approximately 7326 km. Timor-Leste is situated at the crossways of southern Asia and the Pacific Islands. Timor-Leste's waters have free navigation routes



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through the Straits of Ombai and Wetar.

The Tibar Bay Port is Timor-Leste's first PPP, with private financing five times larger than any previous private investment outside the oil and gas sector, and will create 500 local jobs. It will attract private investment of USD360 million over the 30-year life of the Concession, with USD150 million in the construction phase. ...

Timor-Leste has rapidly expanded electricity access to more than 83 per cent of the population but the country has yet to achieve energy security.1 Consumer costs, even with government subsidy, remain high and outages are common. In addition, most of Timor-Leste's electricity is generated through costly and polluting diesel generators.
