How many electricity grids are there in Timor Leste?

The electricity supply of rural Timor Leste now consists of 58 isolated grids (11 on district level and 47 on sub-district level) equipped with diesel generators, although some not operational due to lack of maintenance, fuel or as a consequence of vandalism.

How many people in Timorese have a grid connection?

Only approximately 20% of Timorese people have access to a grid connection, only 10% in rural areas and, even where the connection is available, the supply of electricity from the grid has frequent service interruptions, and connection can be limited to as little as 5 h a day.

Is there a market for roof-top solar energy systems in Timor-Leste?

Australia's Market Development Facility (MDF) and ITP Renewables conducted an assessment of the potential market for roof-top solar energy systems in Timor-Leste.

What is rural energy policy in Timor-Leste?

A key objective is to ensure that the implementation of the government's rural energy programs provides equitable distribution of benefits. In Timor-Leste the Secretary of State for Energy Policy is responsible for the design and implementation of the government's rural energy program.
