However, the first materialistic steps were made only in 2008, when 2,400 solar panels were installed on the roofs of the Vatican's Paul V Hall. It produces over 300 MWh per year. Also, in 2016, the Vatican upgraded and renovated its recycling system, and in 2023 it adopted electric vehicles in partnership with Volkswagen.
