This will be responsible not only for the radio station's power supply, but also for the complete energy supply of the Vatican City State. Recalling that, since 2015 with Laudato Si", he has invited all people of good will to effect changes in their own lifestyles, production and consumption, Francis proposes concrete action from the Holy See.

To do so, the Pope called for solar panels to be installed on Vatican-owned property just outside of Rome. The amount of power to be generated is calculated to be enough to supply Vatican City's energy needs. The Pope authorized the administrators of the Vatican City State to begin transitioning the 110 acres of land it controls into a solar ...
