Wallis and Futuna, officially the Territory of the Wallis and Futuna Islands, is a French overseas collectivity, formed from three Polynesian customary chiefdoms and located in the southern hemisphere. Its capital is Mata Utu, located in the Pacific Ocean 16,000 km from France and 1,900 km from New Caledonia. Demographics: 11,421 inhabitants (2022)
