What is the cooperation between Wallis and Futuna?

Until 2014, cooperation between Wallis and Futuna and the European Union (EU) focused on opening the Territory by strengthening maritime services and port infrastructure. This cooperation continued during the 2014-2020 programming period with support for the creation and development of the digital sector.

Where are the Wallis and Futuna Islands located?

The Wallis and Futuna Islands, nestled in the South Pacific, are a French overseas collectivity. They are divided into 3 main islands and customary kingdoms: Wallis (Uvea), Futuna (Sigave and Alo). The capital, Mata Utu, is located on Wallis. In 2018, these lands were home to approximately 11 500 people.

What does Wallis & Futuna do?

It also provides funding for key development projects in a range of areas, including infrastructure, economic development, environmental management, and health-care facilities. A key concern for Wallis and Futuna is an aging population with consequent economic development issues.

What is happening in Wallis and Futuna?

A key concern for Wallis and Futuna is an aging population with consequent economic development issues. Very few people aged 18-30 live on the islands due to the limited formal employment opportunities. Improving job creation is a current priority for the territorial government. Are Wallis & Futuna members of the Pacific Islands Forum?

How big is the Wallis and Futuna economy?

The economy is limited to traditional subsistence agriculture, with about 80% of labor force earnings coming from agriculture (coconuts and vegetables), livestock (mostly pigs), and fishing.
