What is Wallis and Futuna?

Wallis and Futuna is an overseas collectivity of the French Republic. The collectivity is made up of three traditional kingdoms: Uvea, on the island of Wallis, Sigave, on the western part of the island of Futuna, and Alo, on the island of Alofi and on the eastern part of the island of Futuna.

Where are Wallis and Futuna Islands located?

Wallis and Futuna Islands is an overseas collectivity of France comprising of 3 principal volcanic islands and several small islets, located in the south Pacific Ocean. The Islands lie roughly two-thirds of the way from Hawaii and New Zealand. It is geographically positioned both in the Western and Southern hemispheres of the Earth.

When did Wallis & Futuna join the Pacific Islands Forum?

In 2003, Wallis and Futuna became a French overseas collectivity. The islands joined the Pacific Islands Forum as an associate member in 2018, two years after France's other Pacific territories became full members of the organization. Do Wallis and Futuna still live in New Caledonia?

Despite the split, a significant Wallisian and Futunan community still lives in New Caledonia. In 2003, Wallis and Futuna became a French overseas collectivity. The islands joined the Pacific Islands Forum as an associate member in 2018, two years after France's other Pacific territories became full members of the organization.

How is Futuna Island separated from Wallis Island?

It is separated from Wallis Island to the north by water deeper than 4,500 m (14,800 ft) in the Vitiaz Trench. Futuna island has large Upper Pliocene volcanic lava flows, as well as breccias and hyaloclastite deposits from underwater eruptions.

How many precincts are there in Wallis and Futuna?

Wallis and Futuna (officially, the Territory of the Wallis and Futuna Islands) has 3 administrative precincts (circonscriptions, sing. circonscription). These are Alo, Sigave and Uvea. Uvea, located on the Wallis Island is further subdivided into 3 districts namely, Hihifo, Hahake and Mu'a. Sigave and Alo are located on the Futuna Islands.

Like the islands themselves, places to stay in Wallis and Futuna are small and friendly. In Wallis, visitors have a choice of small quality family hotels, a bed and breakfast, an inn and a guesthouse. Each hotel offers guests a catering service, and there are also restaurants and snack bars on the island.

In Wallis and Futuna, masses are held in church to mark the start of a typical feast day celebration. Wallis and Futuna is an overseas community of France consisting of two small island groupings in Polynesia, near Fiji and Samoa.. In December 2012, cyclone Evan passed through the area. While the smaller of the two islands, Futuna, was relatively untouched, the damages to buildings and infrastructure on Wallis was extensive.

In 1991, BNP Nouvelle-CalÃ©donie, a subsidiary of BNP Paribas, established a subsidiary, Banque de Wallis-et-Futuna, in the territory. Following this, the Bank of Wallis-and-Futuna (BWF) with its head office in Wallis was created in 1991.
